In the 11th century the Knights of Malta, known then as 'Knights Hospitaller', established a hospital in Jerusalem to care for pilgrims of any religious faith or origin. The work of the hospitallers grew in fame and in 1113 Pope Paschal II officially recognised the monastic community as a lay religious order.

Often counted among the better known medieval Christian military orders, the Knights Hospitallers or the Order of Knights of the Hospital of Saint John of Jerusalem ('Ordo Fratrum Hospitalis Sancti Ioannis Hierosolymitani' in Latin) were the older than both Templars and the Teutonic Knights. And unlike the latter two orders, the Hospitallers maintained their bulwark
